THE CONCEPT



The challenge was to create improvements to the property with a more contemporary design, while adapting and engaging surrounding material and existing forms. The intent of the client was to attract new business to the area and provide quick stop shopping for the morning and evening traffic generated by the train station located near by. The solution, a single story brick building with stone base, prominent masonry piers and stucco accents. The canopy at the center entry focuses attention while the tower at the corner anchors the building and provides visual interest, especially for commuters to and from the train station.
