

Cherry Valley Crossing is a 30,000 square foot planned unit development that sits on 4 acres of land in a emerging commercial corridor of the Greater Rockford area. 
STREETSCAPE VIEW

Financial Institution - 3,500 ft²

Cherry Valley Crossing is anticipated to be open in the Spring of 2009. Due to success of the area, and the mixed-use planning more than 60% of the tenants were confirmed before breaking ground on Buildings 1 & 3. Sorce Architecture has worked closely with the Developer providing renderings, presentation documents, and attending promotional banquets to secure tenants and to help market the project. Among the signed tenants is OSF Medical Group, in association with Saint Anthony's Hospital in Rockford, who will be the anchor tenant of the development.
